IMPORTANT SERVICES UNDER THE LAND MANAGEMENT DIVISION

The Land Management Division of the Ministry of Natural Resources & Environment deals mainly with land issues to include land administration, land registrations, land development and land valuation. Services provided support the divisions overall objective towards the "sustainable management of lands and land-based natural resources".

Sections and Services Offered:

1. Land Administration section.

(I) Management of Government Lands

- Purchase any freehold land or interest of any lease in any Government land for the purpose of settlement as farming, urban, commercial or industrial land or for any government purpose;
- Develop land held for any Government purpose;
- Alienate Government land by leasing in accordance with the procedures set out under the Act;
- Reserve from any lease a strip of land for soil or water conservation;
- Exchange the fee simple in any government land for the fee simple of any other land and may receive or pay any sum by way of equality of change.

(II) Management of Customary Land Leases & Licenses

The Land Administration section also administers customary land leases and licenses for the Minister who is the trustee for beneficial owners of customary land in accordance with the requirements of the Alienation of Customary Land Act 1965.

SERVICES OFFERED:

- Leasing of customary lands and government lands
- Allocation of burial plots at Tufuiopa, Vaialele & Maagiagi
- Convey and implement decisions of Land Board

2. Land Development Section.

The Land Development section provides policy advice to the Minister, through the CEO, on all land development matters. This involves the development, research and the review of national policies affecting sustainable development and management of lands and land-based resources. In addition, the section is also responsible for coordinating the implementation of the United Nation Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD), focusing on land degradation as an emerging concern in Samoa.

3. Land Registration Section

The Land Registration is responsible for the registration of all legal land related documents and provides title searches of lands for public. The Registry objective is to confirm ownership and legal title to land. Other land-related documents are also registered for the same purposes.

SERVICES OFFERED:

- Registration of Deeds of Conveyance
- Registration of Mortgages
- Title searches and provide maps, plans and land registry books
- Registration of caveats, transmission, power of attorney
- Registration of leases of customary lands/freehold lands
- Registration of land proclamations

4. Land Valuation section

This sections is responsible for land valuation services to the government, private sector and the public with priority always given to government works. Execute and perform responsibilities of Samoa Valuation Licensing Committee through an issuance of license for valuers and monitor valuation practices. Provide technical advice on land valuation issues and other land matters.

SERVICES OFFERED:

- Valuation of lands and assets for government
- Regulator of valuation practices in Samoa
- Valuation of leases either customary and/or freehold/government lands
- Valuations for business, corporations and individuals
- Valuation for mortgage, loans, stamp duty, death duty
- Issue License and Annual Practice Valuation Certificate

2. Quality Control Section

Graphical presentation of cadastral boundaries, indexing of Land Survey information and Examination of all survey and scheme plans. This section is responsible for the visual presentation of various land boundaries of different ownerships showing areas and other Land information on Index and Cadastral Maps. It is also responsible for issuing Field Books, plan and parcel numbers, receiving and checking all scheme and survey plans deposited by Licensed Surveyors, also preparing of Area Schedules or Legal Descriptions.

3. National Mapping, Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Section

The National Mapping Section is responsible with the reproduction of national maps for the entire nation. One of the core functions of the section is to update and revise the national topographical maps of Samoa at 1:50,000. The National Mapping is a consistent framework for geographic knowledge needed by the nation and it provides public access to high quality geospatial data and information to assist and support decision makers, resource managers and the general public for a sustainable management of natural resources and environment.

The section is also responsible with the operations and maintenance of the ICT for the entire ministry which involves services of all computers and related devices within the ministry, development and update of website for dissemination of information on the internet.

Hey kids!!! When an earthquake strikes.....

- If you are indoors during an earthquake, keep calm and take cover under a heavy table or desk. Stay away from glass, windows or anything that could fall, like a bookcase.
- If you are outdoors, move away from buildings, streetlights and utility wires.
- If you are in a crowded public place, do NOT rush for the doors. Everyone will be doing that. Instead, take cover under something heavy and stay away from things that could fall on you. Stay calm. Do not get in an elevator during an earthquake!
- After an earthquake, be prepared for after shocks. After shocks are follow-up earthquakes that are usually smaller than the first one. They are dangerous because they can cause things that are weakened in the first earthquake to fall down.
- If you are home and you smell gas or hear a hissing or blowing sound, open a window and get out of the building right away. It may mean that a gas line in your house has been broken. Tell your parent or another adult.
- Make sure you are wearing shoes after an earthquake. There may be broken glass on the ground and inside your home.
