

# ART AND WRITING COMPETITION

## “Wanted! Seas and Oceans – Dead or Alive?”

The United Nations Environment Program is inviting young people aged between 6 and 16 years to participate in their art and writing competition to commemorate World Environment Day on the 5<sup>th</sup> of June.

### Entry Rules:

1. Poems and stories should be translated into English and be between 150-250 words
2. Paintings, drawings, cartoons, mosaics etc should be a maximum A3 size. Art paper (or simply manila paper) is preferred although canvas may be used. Crayons, colour pencils, and water paints may be used.
3. Work that has already been shown elsewhere or accepted for another contest should not be submitted
4. All details of the entry form must be completed in English, or be accompanied by a translation in English
5. This includes
  - Full name
  - Birth date (day/month/year)
  - Home address with telephone number
  - Name of school and grade
  - School address including telephone and fax numbers
  - Email address (if you have any)
6. inspiration should be drawn from real day-to-day examples of how workers, families schools and communities are helping to keep our seas alive
7. Entries must arrive on or before **17 May 2004**.

9. Through sponsorship by Bayer the first prize winner will receive a roundtrip air tickets to Bangkok, hotel accommodation, living allowance for themselves and a

parent or guardian, US\$500 cash and a certificate. The second place entry will receive US\$300 and a certificate and the third placed entrant US\$200 and a certificate. All winners will also receive a selection of UNEP publications, including the new resource book for young people *Tunza : Acting for a Better World*

10. Judging will be completed by a panel convened by UNEP, which will include youth leaders
11. Selected entries will be displayed during World Environment Day activities in Bangkok and then included in the website of UNEP/ROAP
12. Announcement of the prize winners will be made in late May 2004.
