The Government of Samoa has received funding from the Climate Investment Funds through the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), toward the cost of the *Enhancing the Climate Resilience of Coastal Resources and Communities Project*, and intends to apply part of the proceeds of these funds to payments under the proposed contract for Consulting Services for project preparation.

The services include the following activities: (i) revision of Coastal Infrastructure Management (CIM) Plans for selected districts in Samoa, in conjunction with other planning frameworks and pilot implementation; (ii) facilitation of increased public awareness and access to information about climate change; (iii) enhanced participation of civil society organizations in climate change adaptation, including provision of more effective climate adaptation services.

The *Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment of the Government of Samoa* now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide evidence showing they are qualified to perform the services, such as demonstrable experience in implementing similar assignments and availability of appropriate skills among staff (this could include documentary evidence such as brochures, company profiles/core business descriptions). Firms may associate in order to enhance their ability to deliver the services.

A firm will be selected under the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) procedures set out in the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers" published in May 2004 and revised in October 2006 and May 2010, which can be found at www.worldbank.org.
